Assessment and Plan

The following list includes any diagnoses that were discussed at your visit.

1. Sinus bradycardia

Since last visit, Nephrology increased Metoprolol from 12.5mg daily to 25mg daily dt elevated BP readings. This resulted in bradycardia (as low as 30s) accompanied by significant weakness and lethargy. He did not have this issue on prior dose.

Decrease Toprol XL to 12.5mg daily (HOLD for HR<60 or SBP <115)
M.aintain BP/HR log

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Tele follow up in 2wks to review

Defer management of HTN to Nephrology- recommend avoiding high dose of BB or NDHP-CCB
Would consider addition of Norvasc or Hydralazine prn

2. Coronary atherosclerosis

s/p CABG x3 7/2015 in Corpus Christi

s/p LHC 12/30/24 with patent LIMA-LAD, patent SVG-RCA and patent SVG to OM, chronically diffusely diseased OM circumflex system, very diminutive caliber

Ct ASA, Statin, Toprol XL

Heart healthy diet

Recommend risk reduction for cardiovascular disease

Recommend follow-up with the primary physician and treatment teams for long-term management of lipids, blood pressure, other medical issues and risk reduction for cardiovascular disease.
